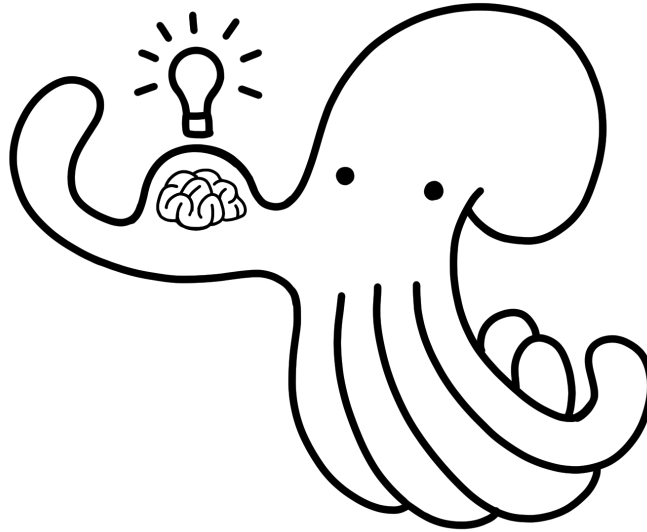


An octopus has parts of its brain in its many arms, which means each of its arms literally has “a mind of its own!”

What would you do if you had eight arms and could do several things at once? Would you do your homework while you play video games? Would you make yourself a sandwich while juggling?

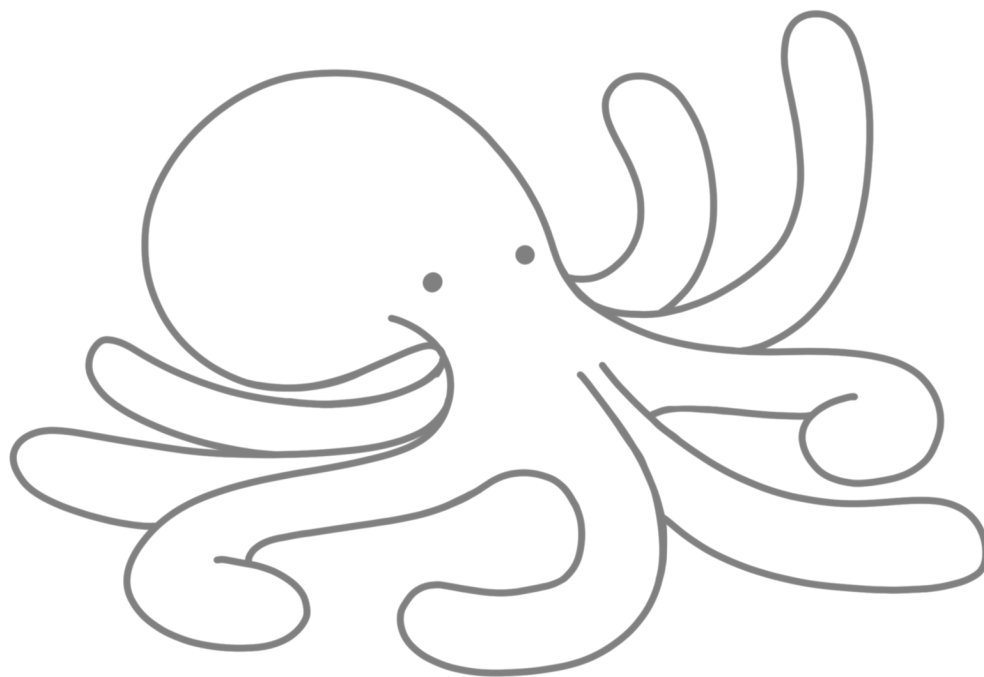
Think about what you would do, and draw yourself with eight arms doing all of those things!

Draw a background for this octopus.

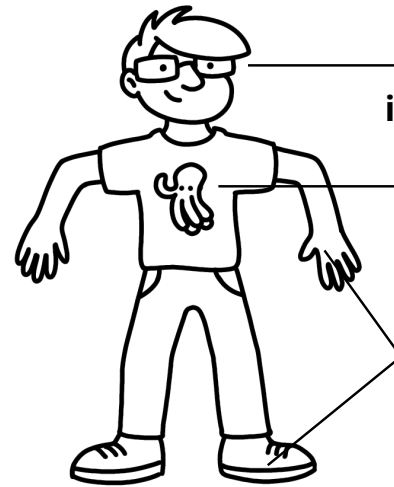
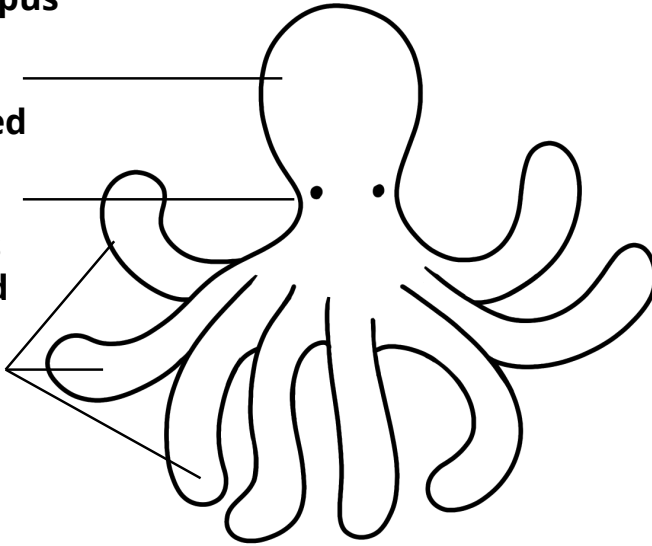
(Is it underwater? Is it on the playground? Is it in your bedroom?)

Octopus bodies are so different from ours! What you THINK is their head is actually their body!

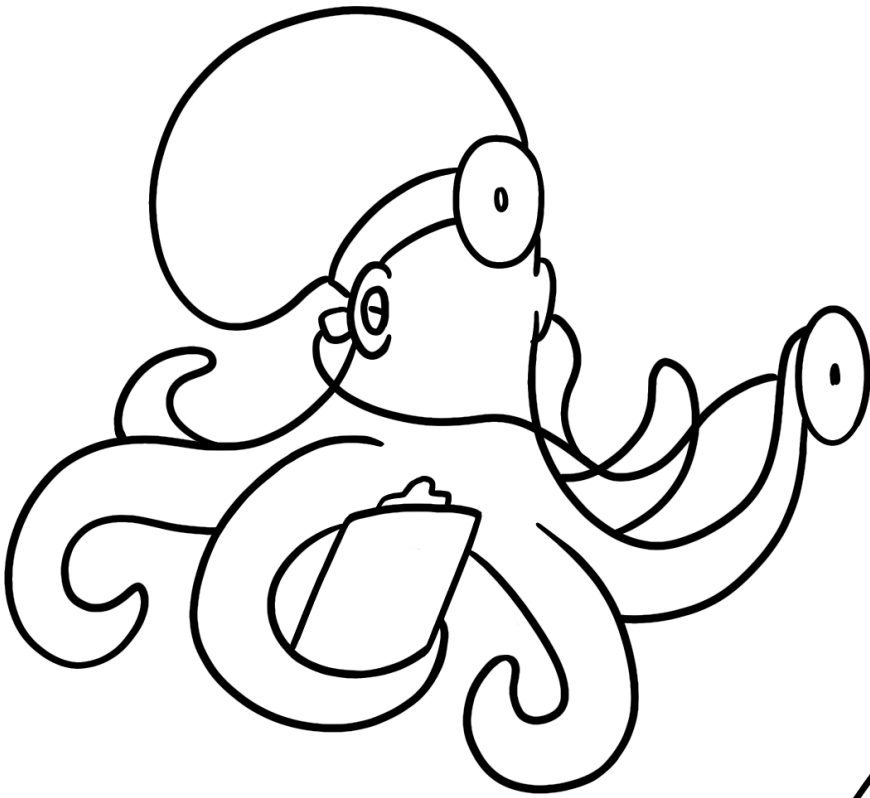
